ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY**

**GENERAL DESCRIPTION:** The Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders in the College of Allied Health at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center announces the availability of a full-time, 12 month, tenure-track Assistant Professor of Speech-Language Pathology position. The major responsibilities of this position include, but are not limited to, the following:

- conducting research in areas of interest, directing student research, and serving on/chairing doctoral dissertation committees;
- submitting extramural research and/or training grants;
- teaching courses in the pre-professional undergraduate program, the professional M.A program in Speech-Language Pathology, and/or the Ph.D. program in Speech-Language Pathology; and
- participating in department, college, and university governance.

**Required Qualifications:** Earned Ph.D. degree or equivalent, CCC-SLP, expertise and active research in developmental speech and language disorders, and potential for successful university teaching, research, extramural funding, and service are required.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Previous university teaching experience is preferred.
