**FOOTNOTES:**

- **1** is required if applicant has not completed a Bachelor's degree. It is recommended that the applicant take an upper level/division (3000 or 4000 level) non-western culture, western civilization & culture, or understanding art forms class. By taking an upper division course in one of those categories, two prerequisites can be completed with that one class.
- **2** is not required for applicants that have an Associate of Science or Associate of Arts degree from an Oklahoma college. Not required for applicants that have a Bachelor's degree. Foreign Language 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> course are waived for applicants who completed two years in the same language in high school. Otherwise, applicant must complete two courses in the same foreign language in college.
- **+** Beginning with 2017 admissions, Foundation Courses are required to be completed **before** the application deadline (March 1st).
- **\*** must be completed prior to beginning the program in the summer if admitted. Please note that preferential points will be given to applicants that have all prerequisites completed by March 1st. Electives are not considered prerequisites.
