POSITION: Assistant/Associate Professor of Nutritional Sciences, Department of Nutritional Sciences, College of Allied Health, University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center, Oklahoma City, OK. One full-time, tenure-track position is available. Starting date is negotiable, Summer or Fall 2016 preferred. Salary commensurate with qualifications and experience. We are searching for candidates with enthusiasm and vision to continue excellence in our dietetic programs and to build a dynamic research program in our Department. The individual filling this position will be expected to develop a research program, write grants, and supervise graduate research projects. Teaching assignments at both the undergraduate and graduate level are negotiable.

QUALIFICATIONS: PhD in nutrition or related field required on or before start date. Preferred, but not required, qualifications include post-doctoral experience, research expertise in obesity/diabetes, cancer or neuroscience, as related to nutrition, and Registered Dietitian credential.

Upload in PDF format the following documents: 1) Cover letter summarizing your interest in, and qualifications for, the position; 2) resume/curriculum vitae; 3) letters of references from 3 individuals qualified to evaluate your potential as a faculty member; and 4) candidate's statement of research interests and professional goals.
