

# CONDITIONS OF USE AGREEMENT FOR UNIVERSITY of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center, College of Allied Health, Department of Rehabilitation Sciences WHEELCHAIR COMPONENTS QUESTIONNAIRE (WCQ)

Public users are not required to seek permission to use the Wheelchair Components Questionnaire (“WCQ”) posted on our website. If you do not agree to the conditions of use, you may not access or use the WCQ.

- The WCQ and any other associated materials are being provided to you under a limited license agreement, subject to the terms stated herein. The license may be revoked at any time, for any reason.
- This license allows you to use a copy of the materials for your personal use.
- You may not sell, rent, lease, lend, sub-license, charge a fee for use, or otherwise commercially exploit the WCQ material in any way without the written permission of LeTourneau University (LETU).
- You may not place the WCQ material on a website.
