FOOTNOTES:

- **1** is required if applicant has not completed a Bachelor’s degree. It is recommended that the applicant take an upper level/division (3000 or 4000 level) non-western culture, western culture, or artistic forms class. By taking an upper division course in one of those categories, two prerequisites can be completed with that one class.
- **2** is not required for applicants who have an Associate of Science or Associate of Arts degree from an Oklahoma college. Not required for applicants who have a Bachelor’s degree. Foreign Language 1st and 2nd course are waived for applicants who completed two years in the same language in high school. Otherwise, applicant must complete two courses in the same foreign language in college.

- **3** can be substituted with Biology I with lab (4 hours minimum) **PLUS** Biology II with lab (4 hours minimum).
- **4** It is recommended that the applicant take an equivalent course to OU course number PSY 2003. If there is not an equivalent course at your college/university for PSY 2003, it is acceptable to take an equivalent course to OU's course numbers PSY 2113, COMM 2513, or ECON 2843.
- *if admitted, must be completed prior to beginning the program in the fall.
- ^ Applicants applying in 2024 will be required to complete a "First-Year Experience" general education course for graduation. The course may be taken prior to applying to OUHSC or the course will be offered after admission to OUHSC for those who haven't taken the course. The CSD Department recommends taking this course prior to admission to OUHSC but it is not required for admission. The course is part of gen ed offered through OU-Norman or maybe an equivalent course approved by OU-Norman.

'Varies' = there are multiple courses that are equivalent for this prerequisite.
