Translating Research Into Practice and Practice Into Research: A Vision for Community & Patient-Centered Science and Healthcare

Dr. Nagykaladi is an Associate Professor and Director of Research in the Department of Family and Preventive Medicine at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center. He is also the Research Director of the Oklahoma Physicians Resource / Research Network (OKPRN). Since 2001, Dr. Nagykaladi has been working closely with healthcare professionals throughout the United States and internationally to improve the quality and safety of healthcare through practice-based and community-engaged health services research. He participated in or led a number of research and quality improvement projects that focused on preventive services delivery, management of chronic conditions, patient and community-centered healthcare, clinical decision support, shared decision making, and the development or implementation of health information technology in primary care settings. Partnering with patients and clinicians, he developed over 20 technology applications that helped improve patient care in Oklahoma and nationally. He also facilitated the development of public-private partnerships, primary care pandemic preparedness, practice facilitation, and community-engaged, participatory research. Dr. Nagykaladi authored over 45 peer-reviewed publications and presented widely on his work. He has also taught and mentored numerous students with various healthcare backgrounds.
