FOOTNOTES:

1 is required if applicant has not completed a Bachelor's degree. It is recommended that the applicant take an upper level/division (3000 or 4000 level) world culture (or non-western culture), western culture, or artistic forms class. By taking an upper division course in one of those categories, two prerequisites can be completed with that one class.

2 is not required for applicants who have an Associate of Science or Associate of Arts degree from an Oklahoma college. Not required for applicants who have a Bachelor's degree. Foreign Language 1st and 2nd courses are waived for applicants who completed two years in the same language in high school. Otherwise, applicant must complete two courses in the same foreign language in college.

+ **Foundation Courses** are required to be completed **prior to** the application deadline (March 1st).

* if admitted, must be completed prior to beginning the program in the summer.

^ 2023 Applicants: Applicants applying in 2023 will be required to complete a General Education: First Year Experience course for graduation. The course may be taken prior to applying to OUHSC or the course will be offered after admission to OUHSC for those who haven't taken the course. The MIRS Department recommends taking this course prior to admission to OUHSC but it is not required for admission. The course is part of gen ed offered through OU-Norman or maybe an equivalent course approved by OU-Norman.

^ 2022 Applicants: Applicants applying in 2022 are in a transition year. If the technical writing course (previously on the prerequisite list) has been completed, then the student will be admitted with the 64 total credit hours requirement and the General Education: First Year Experience course is not required. If the technical writing course has not been completed, then the student may be admitted with 61 total credit hours and the General Education: First Year Experience course will be taken after admission to the Health Sciences Center.

'Varies' = there are multiple courses that are equivalent for this prerequisite.
