Required Qualifications:

- Credential in any medical imaging or radiation therapy specialty
- Minimum of 2-years teaching experience in classroom, clinic, or online
- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited University
- Willing to obtain a Master's degree when the position becomes fully funded

Preferred Qualifications:

- Earned or working toward a Master's degree or a Ph.D. degree

Major Responsibilities:

- Instruct in programmatic and core courses as assigned each semester. These duties may include:

 - Facilitate learning through online media and face-to-face settings
 - Participate in professional development to increase knowledge in course topics that are assigned

Position Description: Instructor in the Radiation Sciences Program. The instructor will focus on teaching program classes in an online format and assisting in core/department classes in a face-to-face or hybrid format. A secondary focus will be on student recruitment in the radiation sciences program. The instructor is expected to be physically present on the OUHSC-OKC campus during the week. The position is funded for 4 years with the potential for full-time status once student growth in the radiation sciences program has been demonstrated.
