RESPONSIBILITIES:

This position will serve as the clinical coordinator and needs to possess the ability to direct the clinical education of nuclear medicine students and participate in the delivery of departmental and programmatic coursework. Demonstrated leadership in professional multidisciplinary interactions and a strong record of verbal and written communication skills is required.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

- Supervise and coordinate nuclear medicine students' clinical education under the direction of the program director.
- Assume responsibility for instruction in programmatic and core courses assigned each semester.
- Supervise, evaluate and advise students in clinical progress
- Participate in the accreditation process under the guidance of the program director
- Participate in the tri-mission (scholarly activity, service and teaching) of the University of Oklahoma as deemed appropriate with your role as faculty member

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- NMTCB or ARRT Certification in nuclear medicine
- Minimum 2-years clinical experience in nuclear medicine
- Minimum 1-year experience instructing students in a JRCNMT accredited nuclear medicine program (clinic or classroom)
- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited University and willing to obtain a Master's degree within 3-years of hire
- Clinical experience in cardiac or PET/CT

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Earned Master's or PhD degree
- Both NMTCB and ARRT certifications
- Advanced certifications with emphasis in cardiac, PET, and/or CT
- Experience in use of instructional technology
- Strong organizational skills
- Flexibility and ability to effectively manage and resolve conflict
- Demonstrates effective verbal, written, and non-verbal communication skills
